September 11, 1956 - July 13, 2019

Gail Squires, of Stafford, VA, passed away on Saturday, July 13, 2019, at her home surrounded by her family after a 91-month battle with glioblastoma. Her neurosurgeon told her she had 6 months to live but she was having none of that. She was 62. She was born in Mount Holly.

Gail worked as a speech pathologist for the Stafford County Schools and with students with speech and hearing disabilities in Burlington County. The NJ youth wrestling community knew her as a warrior wrestling mom who was the source of her sons' toughness.

She is survived by her husband of 40 years, Donald; her sons, Ian (Kaylee) Squires and Drew Squires; grandsons, Adam and Henry; father, Marvin Leedom; sister, Linda (Danny) Morse; numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

She is predeceased by her daughter, Erin Leigh Squires and mother, Janet Leedom.
