



## Jeffrey Scott Worrell

Jeffery Scott Worrell, age 68, died peacefully in his sleep Friday, October 2nd in Williamstown, NJ.

Scott Worrell was born on July 26th, 1952 in Hazlehurst, Mississippi to Edward and Mildred Worrell. Scott spent his childhood years on his family's dairy farm and after moving to New Jersey at the age of six, he would continue to spend the summers there. Having grown up between two farms, Scott developed a deep love of the natural world and spent much of his time in its sanctuary.

He went on to graduate from Rutgers University with a Bachelor's degree in Environmental Science. Upon graduation, Scott travelled to Oregon and was employed by the National Forestry Service. He later continued with his own independence practice of Environmental Consulting, traversing the woods and wetlands of Southern New Jersey. Scott was married to Susan Worrell for 27 years and is survived by their two daughters, Jessica and Melissa Worrell.
