Mrs. Josephine Muller--- resident of the Homestead section of Columbus, NJ---passed away Monday, January 9, 2017 at the age of 93.

Josephine Muller (née Plokhooy) was born September 2, 1923 in Paterson, NJ to Christopher and Mary Plokhooy (née Geary). Mrs. Muller is survived by her son Harold F. Muller Jr., her granddaughter Heidi Muller, her Daughter-in-Law Barbara Hamilton, and several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her brother, Father Christopher H. Plokhooy of Wilimington, DE in 2009, her brother Henry T. Plokhooy of Little Ferry, NJ in 2005, and her husband of 55 years Harold F. Muller Sr. in 2001.

Mrs. Muller attended public elementary and secondary schools in Clifton, NJ. She last worked for Sikora's---a religious goods supplier---in Passaic, NJ.

She was a Third Order Franciscan and member of the Sacred Heart RC church in Mt. Holly, NJ, and St. Andrew's RC Church in Jobstown, NJ. At St. Andrew's she served as a lector, an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharistic, and on the Renew and RC IA teams. She was also a member of the Altar Rosary Society at her current parishes, as well as at her former parish St. Leo's in Elmwood Park, New Jersey.

A 9:30 Franciscan Wake Service, followed by a 10am viewing and 11am Mass of Christian Burial will take place Tuesday, January 17, 2017 at St. Andrew's R.C. Church, Rt. 537, Jobstown, NJ. Interment will be at the BGWCD Veterans' Memorial Cemetery in Arneytown.
