Alan Michael Morrison, age 60, of Lumberton, NJ passed away on September 24, 2017 in Athens, Greece. Born in Mount Holly, NJ on December 29, 1956, he was the beloved son of the late Violet C. Morrison and William J. Morrison, and nephew of the late Dorothy Bareiszis and Helen C. Smith.

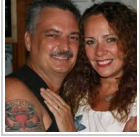
