Albini Joseph Levesque, of Lumberton, NJ, passed away quietly, at his home on June, 8, 2021.

He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Dorothy Wills Levesque. Al also leaves behind a daughter, Linda Levesque, of Amity, Maine; and three sons: Robert Levesque (Jill) Springfield, Massachusetts, Michael Levesque (Connie) Lynchburg, Missouri, Philip Levesque (Nancy) Springfield, Massachusetts. He has 6 grandchildren and 12 great grandchildren. Al is also survived by his sister, Angela Purdy (Ray) Jonesboro, Georgia. Al dearly loved his nieces and nephews from Maine to Georgia, and from New Jersey to Indiana, including James Pondish, Lugoff, SC, and locally, Michael Levesque, Barbara Lennox, Carole Crockett, Charles Lennox, and Mark Wills. He is predeceased by his parents, Eddie Levesque and Mattie Beaulieu Levesque, and brothers: Edgar, Willard, Roland, Clifford and Walter and a sister, Rina Del Priore.

Al was born on October 11, 1934, in St. David, Maine.
