



## Alexander R. Glebocki

December 6, 1947 - September 26, 2023

Alexander R. Glebocki of Millstone, formerly of Florence, passed away on Tuesday, September 26, 2023. He was 75.

Born in Philadelphia, Alexander was a graduate of NE Catholic High School. He served his country in the US Army during Vietnam. Alexander earned his bachelor's degree in psychology at Temple University and went on to get his Master's degree in Public Affairs and Human Services Administration at Rider University.

Alexander dedicated 35 plus years to the mental health field for the State of NJ as he was a Special Projects Manager in the Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services upon retirement. He was very proud of his work with Suicide Prevention.

Outside of work Alexander spent many years serving his community both as a member and Chairman of the Florence Township Zoning Board. He was also very active in the Florence Township Girls Softball League, playing a large role in getting their first field fenced, building dugouts, and having the same field named after an avid female Florence sports fan.

Alexander was a member of the Knights of Columbus #8733 Holy Eucharist Counsel as well as a member of the American Legion Post 194. He also was an accomplished musician, playing the bass in several different bands and more recently, playing in the band at Holy Eucharist Church in Tabernacle. Predeceased by his beloved wife Mary Doyle Glebocki, loving sister Kathleen Glebocki and precious grandson Alec Binetsky, he is also survived by his
