



Alfred "Pat" M. Rossell

December 13, 1926 - January 30, 2014

Alfred "Pat" Morton Rossell of Southampton died Thursday, January 30, 2014 at the Samaritan Healthcare and Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. He was 87.

Born in Pemberton, Mr. Rossell was a longtime Southampton area resident. He served in the Army during WW II and worked as a meat cutter for Al's Market in Vincentown and later for Acme Markets. Pat was a member of the Junior Order United American Mechanics Council #17 of Vincentown and also served as Past State Councilor for the NJ JOUAM. He was also a member of Central Lodge #44 F & AM and the Vincent Fire Co. He was a Charter Member of the Vincentown Emergency Squad, an avid bowler and played baseball for the Vincentown Merchants in his younger years. Mr. Rossell attended Red Lion Faith Chapel.

The father of the late Robert Rossell, he is survived by 3 daughters: Wanda Ballard of Southampton; Amy Lee Meier of Collingswood, and Cheryl Windsor of Manahawkin; 7 grandchildren, 2 great-grandchildren and 3 nephews: Russell Thomas, Jr., Al Thomas, and Jack Rossell.
