Anne G. Townsend of Mount Holly passed away on Thursday, December 7, 2017 at her home surrounded by her family. She was 92.

Born in Plains, GA, Anne was a graduate of Atlantic City High School. She attended Wilson College and was a graduate of George Washington University. Anne was a resident of Mount Holly since 1953. She was the Cherub Choir Director at the First Presbyterian Church for many years and was a member of the Women's Auxiliary to Burlington County Hospital. Anne was known by many for her cooking, baking, and sewing.

The wife of the late John B. Townsend, Anne is survived by her 3 children: Greer Townsend-Gray of Mount Holly, John C. "Kit" and his wife Ann B.
