Anthony J. Falcone of Homestead in Columbus, formerly of Brooklyn, NY, passed away on Thursday, January 4, 2018 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 84.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, Anthony served in the US Army and was a veteran of Korea. After his discharge, he served our country as an inspector & National Import Specialist in US Customs for 41 years. Anthony was a member of the Knights of Columbus and the American Legion. A devoted Catholic, Anthony was a parishioner of Sacred Heart Church in Mount Holly.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 58 ½ years, Virginia; 3 children: Philip and his wife Mimi Falcone, Joanne and her husband Jon Bryson, and Valerie Falcone-Francese; and 5 grandchildren: Matthew, Anthony, Andrew, Charlie, and Linda.
