Anthony J. Leale, “Tony” passed away on Monday, June 9, 2025 at Virtua Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital in Camden. He was 53.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, Tony moved to Mount Holly as a baby. He was a graduate of Rancocas Valley High School, class of 1990. After graduation he worked for Chet’s Home Improvements and Remodeling until a tragic motorcycle accident in 1997 left him paralyzed. Tony never let his disability define him. He was a movie buff and a sports fan. He played fantasy football and other sports. Tony enjoyed going to Eagles and Phillies games but liked the Cowboys and the Yankees. He loved his fish tank and his collectables. He was also the first recipient of the Invincible Award that was presented to him by Vince Papale.

He was preceded in death by his father Steve and mother Barbara. He is survived by his oldest brother Vinny (Laura), his younger sister Jackie; his nieces and nephew: David, Gwen, and Allyson. Tony is also survived by many other family members and friends.
