



Anthony "Poppy" Teleisa

April 19, 1919 - September 26, 2011

Anthony 'Poppy' Teleisa of Mount Laurel, formerly of Clifton and Jersey City, died Monday, Sept. 26, 2011, at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit at Virtua-Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 92.

Born in Jersey City, he was a U.S. Army Veteran of World War II where he served in the South Pacific as a Signal Repairman.

After his discharge, Poppy worked as an electrician for the Bayonne Naval Yard and later for Curtiss Wright Aeronautical, and also owned a deli in Hoboken.

He moved to Mt. Laurel several years ago to be closer to his family.

'Poppy' spent all his free time with his family. He served both his country and his family.

He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Rose; his daughter, Patricia Winsett Teleisa of Westampton; his grandchildren: Michael Winsett and Alisa and PJ Elstone. He was the father of the late Anthony.

He is also survived by two sisters: Flo Bazilus and Ann Sastokas; Nina Hoover, who was like a daughter to him; and his extended family: the

Elstone's, the Russo's, the Malamisura's, and the Cox'; and his caretakers: Kenya, Jermaine, and Koren.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday at 11 a.m. at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mt. Holly.

Friends may visit with the family from 10 to 11 a.m. at the Funeral Home. Interment with military honors will follow at Brig. Gen. William C. Doyle Veteran's Memorial Cemetery in Arneytown.
