April 29, 1965 - June 4, 2023

Audrey Denise (nee Fowler) Lawrence, of Pemberton, passed away on June 4th, 2023 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. She was 58.

A life long Burlington County resident, Audrey was born April 29, 1965 in Mount Holly, NJ to Shirley and the late Edward Fowler and raised in Southampton and spent a lot of time in Chatsworth at her grandparent's house. In 1987 on Halloween night, Audrey met her future husband Joe Lawrence at a party. The two fell in love and were married in 1990. Audrey worked in the insurance industry for over 30 years and was a project manager for Alliant Insurance Services. She enjoyed playing paintball, painting, and crafting. She loved the outdoors and enjoyed going fishing and hiking, and most recently started farming and bee keeping as a hobby with her husband. Audrey was also an avid reader and well as loved horror movies. Another hobby of Audrey's was baking cookies, and during the Christmas season, with the help of her husband and friends would bake hundreds of Christmas cookies for friends and loved ones. Audrey was also an animal lover, especially her dogs and cats. She loved life and was described by her co-worker as "Always a good and decent person, who never had a cross word for anyone. Thrown into difficult situations, she was always positive, honest, and kind." She will be deeply missed.

Audrey is survived by her beloved husband of 32 years Joe Lawrence, her mother Shirley Fowler, brother Carl Fowler (Brenda), her sister from another mother Amy Mclaughlin, her two dogs Sydney and Vanilla, her three cats

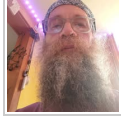

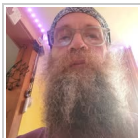
