



## Augustus A. "Al" Runcie

July 21, 1926 - April 23, 2014

Augustus A. "Al" Runcie, longtime Mt. Holly resident passed away Wednesday, April 23, 2014 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mt. Holly. He was 87. A dedicated patriot to his country both overseas and at home, Al was a retired Sergeant for the US Army after 21 years of service, then spent another 20 years in Civil Service as an Accounting Supervisor at Fort Dix, only to become a NJ State Corrections Officer at the age of sixty and retired at the rank of Sergeant not long ago at the age of 81.

An extremely generous and giving person, Al was a devoted husband to his late wife Magdalena, caring father, and grandfather. He loved reading and was an avid animal lover who always cared for his cats and especially his adopted dog, "Boo Bear Cita."

Husband of the late Magdalena Runcie, he is survived by his daughter, Maria C. Runcie; two sons, Patrick C. Runcie, Richard B.
