Barbara M. Groves of Hainesport died Saturday, January 24, 2009 at her residence. She was 84.

Born in Moorestown, Mrs. Groves was a longtime area resident. She worked for RCA, Unisys and later for Burlington County. Barbara was a ballroom dancer for over 35 years. She won National Honors for her dancing in Florida in the mid 1980's. She continued dancing until she was 82 years old. She was a member of Queen of Peace Catholic Church in Hainesport.

The wife of the late Benjamin, Mrs. Groves is survived by 3 children: son Michael Benjamin Groves of Chapel Hill, NC; daughter Kathleen Barbara Groves of Hainesport; and daughter Constance Patricia Groves of Eastampton; a grandson Isaac Christopher Groves; 2 great-grandchildren Otis & Jubilee. 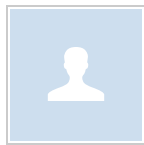
