Bernard C. Conlee passed away in his Florida home on Saturday, July 11, 2015. He was 90. Bernard was raised in Jamestown, KS. He began working on the farm in his early youth. This set the stage for Bernard to have a strong work ethic all his life.

Bernard went into the US Navy in 1942 and served in the Pacific on the carrier, USS Langley. While stationed in Philadelphia, he met and married the love of his life, the late Catherine Owens Conlee. They were married for 63 years.

Most of Bernard's work career was at McGuire AFB where he worked for the Dept. of Civil Engineers.
