Beverly Jean Hancock, 75, of Westampton, NJ passed away on Monday, June 17, from complications of Mantle Cell Lymphoma. Her beloved children were by her side.

Beverly was born December 16, 1943, in Bridgeton, NJ to Garth LeRoy and Esther Elizabeth Harbison Gongloff. Through her Christian upbringing, she developed a passion for helping others. As a young woman, she obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree in Teaching English and History from Montclair State University and later a Master's degree in Counseling from Temple University. Not only did Beverly help young people in these settings, but she also opened her home to troubled youth and provided them with love and security, which they otherwise would not have experienced.

Beverly was kind-hearted, loving, and selfless. It didn't matter what she was going through, she always placed everyone else's needs above her own. She celebrated life and was grateful for every day and all that God blessed her

with. She cherished her late husband of 45 years, James Everett Hancock Jr., her children James Michael Hancock and Faith Lynn Borradaile (Tom), and only grandchild Madison Elizabeth Borradaile, and loved them all unconditionally. Beverly enjoyed sewing, reading, and spending time with her family and friends but her greatest joy was watching her children and granddaughter learn, grow, and experience the beauty of the world that God created.
