Brian S. Scarborough passed away suddenly in Key West, Florida July 31, 2018.

Brian was born in New Brunswick, NJ and spent his early years in Monmouth Junction and Kendall Park, NJ before moving to Bradenton, FL. He graduated from Bradenton High School in 1983.

Brian was employed by AMTRAK in New York, while living in New Jersey. He transferred to AMTRAK in Oakland, CA.
