C. Edman Budd of Southampton Township (Leisuretowne) passed away Thursday, March 29, 2018 at Samaritan Hospice, Virtua Memorial Hospital Mt. Holly, NJ. He was 88 years old.

Early years he resided in Pemberton NJ, he later resided in Southampton Township for many years until his passing.

After graduating from Hun School in Princeton, NJ he worked in the family business, T.H. Budd & Sons, a blueberry and cranberry farm and ran the farm for 30 years.

Through the many years of Ed's life he was involved in many aspects of the community: Lenape and Southampton Township school boards and lastly, for many years, served as a Southampton Township Committeeman.

In earlier years he served on Board of Directors for Tru-Blu Co-op, and Board of Grower Cranberry Co., was a member of Cranberry Mktg. Committee for Ocean Spray. Also, a member of Burlington County Board of Agriculture and member of Tech Staff for Burlington County Soil Conservation. In 1994, Ed retired after 25 years as supervisor of the Southampton Twp. Public Works Department.

Ed was an outdoorsman who loved to duck hunt and surf fish at the Jersey Shore, and loved to just be in the woods or at the farm with his beloved dogs Magoo and Sam.

Ed was predeceased in death by his parents, brothers Don and Ted, sister Margaret, sons Keith and Cliff Jr. and Ed's wives Pat and Peg. Ed is survived by wife Carolyn of 28 years, sons David, Craig (Kathryn), Jimmy (Roxy), Timmy (Vickie), William (Linise), and daughter Jessica (Don); stepson, Bruce Pittman (Wendy); fourteen grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren, as well as nephews Tom, Ted, and George, and niece Susan.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, April 14th at the Vincentown United Methodist Church, 97 Main Street, Vincentown, NJ.
