



Carl H Goodfellow

November 25, 1942 - November 16, 2016

Carl H. Goodfellow of Southampton passed away on Wednesday, November 16, 2016 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly surrounded by his family. He was 73.

Born in Woodbury, Carl was a 1961 graduate of Rancocas Valley High School. He started his lifelong sewer and water career helping his father run the Hampton Lakes sewer plant. He held several public sewer, wastewater, and water treatment and supply licenses and worked as sewer plant superintendent in several area towns. He founded Marlis Consulting, which contracted with local townships to manage water and wastewater treatment plants. Carl also worked part-time at Flanagan's Gas Station, Lake Pine Mobile, and Medford Lakes Lodge Liquor Store. He also drove a Rolls Royce for weddings.

Carl was a past member of the NJ Water Environment Association, past Assistant Fire Chief and founding member of the Medford Lakes Fire Department, a member of the America Emergency Squad, and the Medford Emergency Squad.

Carl is survived by his wife of 54 years, Christine; 2 children: Mark Goodfellow of Southampton and Lisa (Daniel) Siatkowski of Southampton; his grandchildren: Kyle, Christopher, Sean, & Erika; 3 step-grandchildren:

Charles, Tracey and Lisa and 3 step-great grandchildren: Haleigh, Zoeigh and Reagan. Predeceased by his brother J. Wesley Goodfellow Jr., he is survived by his brother J. Earl (Cindy) Goodfellow & sister Mary (Art) Sticklin, sister-in-law: Dorothy and several nieces and nephews.
