



Carlos A. Rodriguez

July 23, 1942 - April 19, 2014

Carlos A. Rodriguez, longtime Pemberton resident, passed away Saturday, April 19, 2014 at Samaritan Inpatient Hospice in Mt. Holly. He was 71. Born in Coamo, Puerto Rico, he was a retired Army Sergeant 1st Class who served three tours of duty in the Vietnam War and was the recipient of a Bronze Star and Army Commendation Medal for his bravery and service to a grateful nation. After retiring from the Army, he ultimately retired as a Federal Investigator for the US Equal Employment Opportunity Commission. A kind and selfless man, Carlos was well known in his neighborhood as the local handyman who was always willing to help fix anything. He was a member of Christ the Redeemer RC Church in Mt. Holly and the Knights of Columbus Council 7814.

He is survived by his wife of over 42 years, Evelyn; two children, Luis Rodriguez (Tammie), Jennie Espada (Eric); five grandchildren, Ivan, Malik, Jaden, Jennessa, Jenevieve; his mother and father-in-law, Luis & Juanita Reyes; a sister-in-law, Wanda Smith (Robert); brother-in-law, Luis Reyes (Alita); three siblings, William, Jaime, Aida; and many nieces and nephews.
