Carlton Harker, Jr. died April 1st , 2011 at Buttonwood Hospital in Pemberton Twp. He was 88. Carlton was born on September 7, 1922 in Lumberton (Frog Town) at the home of his parents, Carlton and Maxine Harker. He was predeceased by his companion Anna Cramer, his parents and his sisters, Lucille Carter, Mary Devlin and Maxine Powell.
