



## Carlton E Hendy

February 25, 1954 - April 21, 2014

Carlton E. Hendy of Mount Laurel passed away peacefully, Monday, April 21, 2014 at Virtua-Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 60.

Born in New York City, Mr. Hendy grew up in Sag Harbor, the Bronx, and Manhattan, he attended Walsh University in Canton, OH, where he met his wife, Beth and they moved back to NY, St. Croix, and settled in Burlington County. He was a longtime Car Salesman and had worked for Barlow Chevrolet, Lucas Ford, and Lucas Chevrolet. Carlton enjoyed Fantasy Football and participated in two leagues.
