Carolyn A. Reber of Lumberton died Friday, December 6, 2013 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. She was 90.

Born in Philadelphia, Mrs. Reber was a graduate of Upper Darby High School. During WW II, she trained and was certified as an Auxiliary Fire Fighter and ran fire calls. She and her husband moved to NJ in 1965 and she worked in various secretarial jobs and last worked part-time as a receptionist for a doctor in Williamstown.
