Carolyn Sue Hickman (nee Hamric) of Mount Holly, NJ died on May 27, 2013 at Brandywine Estates in Moorestown of natural causes. She was born in Parkersburg, West Virginia on February 10, 1931. Her husband H. Lyndon Hickman, a career English teacher, died in 1991. They were married for 37 years. She was the daughter of the late Edwin Lee & Mabel Hughes Hamric of Parkersburg, WV.

Susie graduated from Parkersburg High School and received a bachelor's degree from Ohio University. A loving and devoted wife, mother, and grandmother, she had a beautiful smile, a positive spirit, and a very kind heart. Sue taught first grade in Cleveland Ohio before moving to Mt. Holly in 1960. Started her teaching career in Kindergarten in Mt. Holly and spent most of her career in Room 2 of the Folwell School. Annually at Halloween, she dressed up as a witch, which was the opposite of her personality. Sue was kind and compassionate and loved all aspects of life and people. She loved the Columbus Farmers Market, sewing, and a Costco hotdog. She was also known for her expansive collection of teddy bears and had a different one for each day of the year. She was a longtime member of the NEA, NJEA, Delta Kappa Gamma, Mt. Holly Auxiliary to Virtua Memorial, the Female Benevolent Association, and First Baptist Church of Mt. Holly.

She is survived by two sons: Frederick L. and wife Barbara of Clarks Summit,

PA with granddaughter Carolyn and grandson Freddie, and Andrew L. and wife Robin with granddaughter Leah and husband Gary Ledford.
