



## Charles B. "Chuck" Tucker

August 3, 1940 - December 22, 2022

Charles B. Tucker, "Chuck" of Southampton, passed away on Thursday, December 22, 2022 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 82.

Born in Philadelphia, Chuck attended Trenton Junior College and earned his Bachelor's degree at Monmouth College. He was a retired middle school teacher. He taught American History in the Pemberton Township School District. Chuck was a member of the Pemberton Township Education Association, the BCEA, the NJEA, and the NEA. He loved subscribing to National Geographic. Chuck enjoyed hunting and was a member of the Garden State Gun Club, and the NRA. He was a member of the Woodmen of the World. Chuck was also a longtime member of St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Mount Holly.

He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Jo Ann; a son and daughter-in-law: Chuck II and Dawn Tucker of Marlton; a daughter J.
