Charles C. Yoos of Mount Holly went to be with our Lord on December 7th, 2011. He was 84. Charlie was born and raised in Mt. Holly. He joined the United States Air Force and honorably served his country during the Korean conflict and the Vietnam war. He piloted numerous missions in Korea and was the recipient of the Distinguished Flying Cross. He flew in search and rescue missions in Alaska, returning to McGuire AFB to transport military patients for medical care as an air evacuation pilot before retiring from the Air Force.

Charlie was a lifelong member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, serving as an usher for over 50 years. He was also active in the Boy Scouts, the McGuire chapter of the Daedalians, St. Paul's men's prayer breakfast, and the Lions Club where he served as the eyeglass chairman for many years.

Charlie was an avid sportsman and loved bowling, golfing, fishing and camping, especially in Maine. He was a lifelong fan of the Eagles and Phillies.

Charlie was the beloved husband of Roberta (Bert) for 61 years, devoted father of Patricia (Kenneth) Johnson, Cheryl (Alan) Dennison, and Charles Jr. (Sydney) Yoos. He was the adored grandfather of Stephen Johnson, Jessica Johnson, Alan Dennison Jr., Todd Dennison, Stephanie Dennison, and Nick (Monica) Batastini. He was the great grandfather of Johnathan Batastini. He is also survived by his brother, Harold Yoos, sister, Elizabeth Polidora, brother-in-law, James Potts, and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.
