Charles R. Johnson, lifelong Lumberton resident, passed away Wednesday, November 27, 2013 at Burlington Woods in Burlington Twp. He was 92. As a US Navy and Coast Guard veteran, he served on the USS General W.H. Gordon during World War II. Charlie had spent most of his life dedicated to the town of Lumberton from being one of the first Police Officers in town, to spending almost thirty years as head custodian of the Florence L. Walther School.

Within those times, he had served as the Civil Defense Director, Life Member of the Lumberton Fire Co., member of the Lumberton Historical Society, the Last Man's Club of Lumberton, the NJ Fraternal Order of Police, and the Mt. Holly VFW Post #2692. Charlie had also spent time as a carpenter and cabinet maker which led him into carving decoys and birds. He also enjoyed painting. Lumberton curbside shoppers already miss his exceptional tomatoes! With all of his civic duties and interests, he was always able to find time to enjoy with his beloved family. One of his last achievements was being acknowledged and honored as the oldest Lumberton Resident in 2010.

Husband of the late Bette S. Johnson, he is survived by his two daughters, Charleen Gottschalk (Marty), Elaine Jardine (John); a grandson, Christopher Jardine, a sister-in-law, Marie Kaelin, and a brother-in-law Charles T. Simon. Funeral service will be held 11 am, Wednesday, December 4, 2013, at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mt. Holly. Interment will follow in the Evergreen Cemetery, Lumberton.
