July 23, 1952 - August 3, 2018

Christine Joyce Pepper of Tabernacle passed away on Friday, August 3, 2018 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Voorhees surrounded by her family. She was 66.

Born in Mount Holly, Christine was a graduate of Lenape High School. Her passion for corvettes started early, as she was Atco Raceway's Powderpuff Derby Queen at age 17. That passion continued as she owned many corvettes through the years in many different colors. She also had a great passion for animals, specifically French Bull Dogs. When she was a little girl she used to dress up her cats in doll clothes and walk them around in doll carriages. Over the years Chris had owned Bassett Hounds and Beagles. These dogs were treated like her children. Chris also had a strong faith and enjoyed going to church. She was a practicing Pentecostal who loved sharing His message. She worked in all kinds of jobs throughout her life: a hairdresser, landscaper, manager of a plant nursery and even a union laborer on a bridge building crew. She made that pink construction hat look good. Her last job was for Occupational Training Center helping those suffering from mental disabilities. Chris was known best for being a "GIVER". She had a knack for gifting little trinkets to everyone in beautifully decorated packages. These gifts were special because they had some unique meaning in her relationship to the recipient. She always put everyone else first.

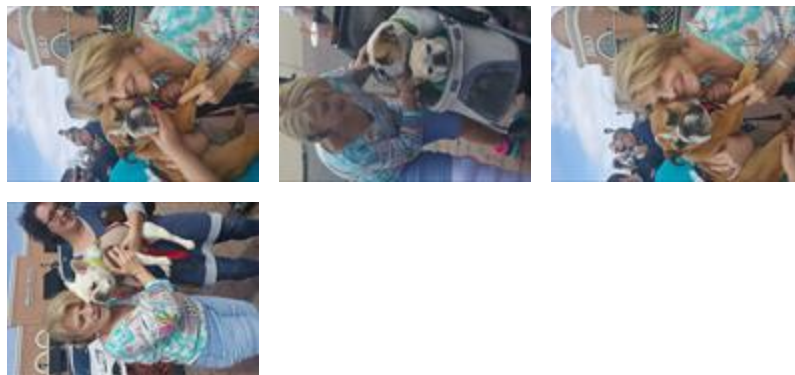
