Clara Gulli, of Westampton, died peacefully on Monday, July 1, 2024 at her daughter's residence in West Lawn, PA after a courageous battle with metastatic lung cancer. Born and raised in Freehold, NJ; the daughter of the late James and Kathryn (Cooney) Collins.

Clara attended St. Rose of Lima grade school in Freehold, Cathedral High School in Trenton, and received her Bachelor of Science degree in nursing from William Paterson College.
