Clare Yelito of Lumberton died Wednesday May 27th, 2009 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. She was 88. Mrs. Yelito was born in Philadelphia, the daughter of the late Joseph and Maryann Rosowski Klimkowski. She was a former payroll clerk for the Frankfort Arsenal in Philadelphia. After moving to Lumberton, she was a waitress for many years at both the Vincentown Diner and Merion Caterers.
