Clifford Michael Scott [Scotty] of Jobstown passed away on June 23, 2026 at home with his wife present. He was 75. Born in Liverpool, England, Cliff grew up as an Air Force "brat" and lived in many different places. He graduated from HS in Dayton, Ohio, and joined the Air Force. After his Honorable Discharge as a sergeant, he went on to attend BCCC, Trenton State College, and Philadelphia College of Textiles and Science. Cliff taught Industrial Arts and Technology at Shawnee HS for 29 years. He learned to repair computers, and he was invaluable in assisting the staff. For several years, he coached Shawnee girls cross country and track, and was occasionally an assistant for the boys team at Shawnee and Northern Burlington HS. Cliff later became an adjunct at Burlington County College, and most recently, an Immigration Officer for the Department of Homeland Security. Cliff was intelligent, highly motivated, and always learning. He liked reading about History and working on improvement projects at home, He enjoyed running, and completed a marathon in Rome . He was featured in a movie about that race.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Lois [nee Rue], and a son Collin and spouse, Chuck, of Mount Ephriam. He was the Father of the late Todd.
