March 22, 1925 - July 30, 2016

Conly D. Brooks, Jr. of Mount Laurel, formerly of Mount Holly, passed away on July 30, 2016 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. He was 91.

Born in Westmont, Mr. Brooks was a longtime Mount Holly resident. He was a US Navy Veteran of WW II and later was a civil service electrician. Conly was a member of the Mount Holly VFW Post #2692 and the American Legion Post #509. He was a former member of the Union Fire Co., and the Mount Holly AA. Conly was a longtime Rancocas Valley Regional High School Sports supporter and had worked the chains for many years at the football games. He enjoyed hunting, was a Phillies fan, and just loved sports in general.

Conly is survived by his wife of 67 years, Jane; 3 children: Conly D. Brooks, III of Hainesport, Janice L (Warren) Schuler of Florida; & Kathleen B.
