Connie L. Anderson, Jr. of Jobstown died Monday October 5th, 2009 at his residence. He was 75. Mr. Anderson was born in Plainsboro, NJ, the son of the late Connie and Gladys Strine Anderson Sr. He was a 1951 graduate of Pemberton High School and a former member of the Springfield Twp. Board of Education. Mr. Anderson was engaged in dairy and crop farming in Jobstown since 1955 and was in the lime spreading business since 1970. He was a local and state scripture chairman for Gideons International and a past president of the Burlington County and New Jersey National Farmers' Associations. Mr. Anderson was a member and Deacon of Pemberton's First Baptist Church.

Mr. Anderson is survived by his wife, Marilyn Hutchinson Anderson; four children: Louane Joyce Powers of Elgin, SC, David Scott Anderson of Jobstown, Elizabeth Jeanne Hagen of Sterling, VA and Brian Keith Anderson of Jobstown; 7 grandchildren, 2 step grandchildren and 3 step great grandchildren. He is also survived by two sisters: Catherine Norcross of Mount Holly and Doris Valentine of Spring Hill, FL.
