David Kelly Sutphin, “Kelly”, passed away on Saturday, October 28, 2023 at his home in Medford. He was 72.

Born in Mount Holly, the son of the late Gerald K. Sutphin and Virginia Wells Smith, Kelly was a longtime area resident. He was a graduate of Lenape Regional High School where he was a member of the Varsity football and baseball teams. He earned a baseball scholarship to Spring Garden College in Philadelphia and got his degree in Architectural Design.

After college, he worked for Award Homes and was a Project Manager for Bob Meyer Communities in Medford. Most recently, he formed D. Kelly Sutphin Construction.
