



## Rev. Daniel F. Cline

January 26, 1922 - July 13, 2018

Rev. Daniel F. Cline of Westampton, NJ died Friday, July 13 at Samaritan Hospice in Mt. Holly.

Born January 26, 1922 in Mt. Holly, Dan attended the Mt. Holly schools and graduated from Rancocas Valley Regional High School in 1939. He served in the US Army in Europe during World War II. After the war, he graduated from Rider College in 1949 with a BA in Accounting and began his first career as a successful businessman as President of Chesley and Cline Insurance and co-founder of Chesley, Cline and Alloway Realty. He was active in the Mt Holly business and civic community in the 1950's and '60's.

In mid-life, he earned a Masters of Divinity from Eastern Baptist Theological Seminary and was ordained an elder in the United Methodist Church. He then began his second career as a pastor at United Methodist churches in Camden, Burlington and Ocean Counties, including Magnolia, Bordentown, Blackwood and Smithville. In addition, he was Pastor Emeritus at the First United Methodist Church Mt Holly, where he was a lifelong member, and was on the pastoral rotation at the United Church of Surf City and the Hungarian Reformed Church in Roebling.

He was an avid Philadelphia sports fan, a world traveler and a loving family man.

He was the son of the late Edwin and Ella Mae Cline. He was predeceased by his brother Edwin Cline and sister Bertha Sontag. He is survived by his wife Joan of Westampton, his son Frederick of Lawrenceville, NJ, and his nephew Jeffrey Sontag of Toms River.

Relatives and Friends are invited to his visitation on Tuesday evening from 6-8 PM at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly. A Memorial Service will be held on Wednesday at 11:00 AM at the Funeral Home. Burial in Park View Cemetery in Medford Village will be private.
