



## Daniel Thomas Schweikert

October 22, 1934 - May 13, 2014

Daniel T. Schweikert, 79, long time resident of Willingboro, died on May 13, 2014. Daniel was born in Middle Village, Queens, NY on October 22, 1934. He is predeceased by his parents, Daniel and Lillian (McGuinness) Schweikert, and sister, Maureen (Olin) MacNeil.

Loving and devoted husband, father, and grandfather, Daniel is survived by his wife, Veronica (Loennecker), of 55 years; four daughters, Mary Ann Hutchison (Joseph), Theresa Beaver (Gene), Kathleen Schweikert, Patricia Gurba (Andrew); nine grandchildren, Colleen, Christine, Kimberly, Daniel, John Hutchison, Michael Beaver, Kathleen, Elizabeth, Sean Gurba; and many cousins, nieces, nephews, and brothers and sisters –in-law.
