David J. Conover, age 73, passed away suddenly on Monday, Sept 4, 2017 at Albany Medical Center with his family by his side. Born in Mt. Holly, NJ, he lived most of his life in Pemberton, NJ then retired to Andes, NY. He graduated from Rancocas Valley High School in 1964, more recently serving on their alumni committee. He then continued on to graduate from RCA Electronic School. David worked for the Burlington County Superintendent Board of Elections for over 25 years. He also owned Conover Electronics, a television and electronic repair shop. He was a very active member of United Methodist Church and Cabinhill Presbyterian Church of Andes, NY. Mt. Holly Masonic Lodge #14, ELKS lodge 848, Burlington County Shrine Club and Scottish Rite Freemasonry. While living in Pemberton, he also served several terms as Burlington County committeeman.

Never afraid to speak his mind, David was direct and honest but always there to pick you up if you fell. He had a compassionate soul with a great love for nature, animals, mechanics, and especially his family. He was predeceased by his parents Joseph L. Conover (1991) and Grace Conover (1968).
