In the early morning of January 2, 2025, David “Dave” Dobbins, 63, beloved father and brother, of New Egypt, succumbed to his lengthy battle with essential thrombocythemia and acute myeloid leukemia (AML).

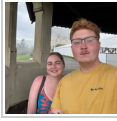
