Delroy A. Malcolm, Sr., of Mt Holly formerly of Philadelphia PA, passed away suddenly on Thursday, March 26, 2026 at his home. He was 56. Delroy brought peace, joy, and loyalty into every relationship. He remained close to childhood friends, cherished his family deeply, and was always ready to help anyone—family, friend, colleague, or stranger. Standing 6'2" and 270 pounds, he was a gentle giant with a heart of gold.

On the golf course and in life, Delroy created, taught, supported, and led with humility. He understood excellence as a quiet form of intelligence, and he lived it every day.

Delroy Sr. will be remembered as a strong, kind, and genuine man whose presence made the world better for everyone who knew him.
