Dennis Prusinoski of Eastampton, NJ passed away on Saturday Nov 26, 2022 at Virtua Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 71 years old. 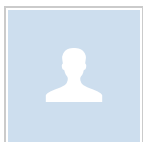
