Dennis A. Wargo of Delanco, formerly of Willingboro, passed away suddenly on October 23, 2015 at Lourdes Hospital in Willingboro. He was 73.

Born in Trenton and a graduate of Trenton Catholic High School, Dennis served as a Corporal in the Marine Corps in Vietnam. He was a graduate of St. Joseph's University and worked as a systems analyst for Carter-Wallace Inc. in Cranbury.

Dennis was a longtime coach and volunteer with the Corpus Christi CYO basketball, softball, and baseball programs. He served on the Burlington County Catholic Basketball League Executive Board and assisted with the NJ State CYO basketball tournament for several years.

An avid fisherman, he could be found with a fishing pole in his hands every day the weather was good. He also enjoyed bowling and traveling with family and friends. Dennis was a devoted fan of St. Joe's basketball and always believed "The Hawk Will Never Die."
