



## Diane Doris Brockway

November 13, 1946 - March 5, 2011

Diane D. Brockway (nee DuBell) of Columbus died Saturday, March 5, 2011 at Lourdes Hospital in Willingboro. She was 64.

Born in Columbus, Mrs. Brockway was a longtime Mansfield Township resident. She was a graduate of Northern Burlington High School and Rider University. Mrs. Brockway taught Business Occupations at BCIT for 30 years. She was also a longtime advisor for the Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) at BCIT. Mrs. Brockway was a member of the Come Alive Church in Medford.

She is survived by her husband of 42 years, Howard William Brockway; a son and daughter-in-law: Scott and Carrienne Brockway of Juliustown; and a grandson Scott Brockway, Jr. She is also survived by her brother Herbert H. DuBell (Jeanie) of Columbus.
