Dominick J. Repici, 92, of Woodland Twp. Passed away peacefully at home on Friday, August 12, 2016 with his family by his side.

Dominick was a survivor of WWII, having served in Anzio, Sicily, North Africa, and France. He was wounded in action and received a Purple Heart for his service. He was employed by Foy Electric, working in the family business until 1955. He then worked for the Federal Government starting at McGuire AFB, retiring after 30 years of service including time working at the Bowmarc Missile Site. Dominick was a member of the American Legion and VFW.

He was predeceased by his wife, Louise and former wife Bernice, as well as siblings Catherine Repici, Sara Foy, and John Repici. He leaves to mourn his children Patricia and Robert Tice and Thomas J. and Jo Ann Repici. He is also survived by step-son Charles Bozarth as well as grandchildren Janet Tice, Melissa Rauch (Rich), Thomas, Jr. (Kathy), and Joelynn Owens (Steven); step-grandchildren Debbie (Kurt), Kelly (Shane), Wendy, Chrystal (Jay), Lauren (John), Justin, and Brittney (Nabel).
