Dona Faye Jenkins of Browns Mills, passed away on Wednesday, October 12, 2016 at Cooper Hospital in Camden, surrounded by her family. She was 72.

Born in Mount Holly Hospital, the daughter of the late Matthew Turner and Esther Gladys Sooy, Dona Faye was a lifelong Browns Mills resident and graduate of Pemberton High School. She worked as a secretary in the family business, J.W. Jenkins and Sons Well Drilling, Inc. Dona Faye was active in the PTO at Pemberton Schools, was a member of the Pemberton Lions Club, and was an active volunteer at all Township Community Events. She was also integral in both the original and revamped Imagination Kingdom Playground.
