Donald J.L. Rinyu, 37, of Pemberton, NJ unexpectedly passed away Monday, February 25, 2019. Donald was a 2000 graduate of Pemberton Township High School before serving in the New Jersey National Guard. A Veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom, Donald served his country until his honorable discharge in 2007.

Donald is survived by his wife Krystal, and their two daughters Cheyanna and Kaellyn, and his service dog Odin.

He is also survived by his father Philip Freeman, his brothers Philip and Kevin Freeman, his sisters Jennifer Martinez and her husband Jose, Debra Freeman, Lora Kirchner, and Lisa Reaves and her husband Jeff. He also leaves behind eight nephews and four nieces. Last, but certainly not least, Donald is remembered fondly by numerous friends and extended family.

In death, Donald has continued to help his fellow man by becoming an organ and tissue donor.

An avid hunter and fisherman, Don enjoyed his time in the woods and at the lake, although he could also be found from time to time in his forge taking metal and making it into various designs. However, if asked he would probably

tell you that the greatest love of his life was his motorcycle, followed by his family.
