Doris M. Nixon, of Vincentown, New Jersey, passed away on November 14th, 2021 while surrounded by her loving family. She was 93 years old.

Daughter of the late Arthur and Clara Pepper, Doris was born June 4th, 1928 in Tabernacle, New Jersey where she was raised as a good old-fashioned farm girl.
