



Dorothea M. Shinn

January 20, 1929 - June 17, 2024

Dorothea M. Shinn of Clermont, FL passed away peacefully on June 17, 2024. She was 95. She was preceded in death by her husband Norman E. Shinn and brother John Moller.

Dorothea (Dot) was a 1948 graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School. She was a long-time member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church (Hainesport) where she was a member of the Ladies Circle, a Sunday School teacher, and a council member. She was a former member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Masonville Fire Department. Dot retired from her position of Office Manager at Moorestown Gardens in 1992. She and Norm retired to Jim Thorpe, PA shortly after where they became active in their community of Penn Forest Streams. In 2007 she moved back to NJ, and in 2022 moved to Clermont, FL.
