



## Dorothy "Dottie" Claire Smith

March 8, 1932 - January 22, 2026

Dorothy (Dottie) Claire Smith, 93, passed away in Moorestown, New Jersey on Thursday, January 22. Born on March 8, 1932 in Conshohocken, Pennsylvania to parents Orrie S. Lillard and Anne (Haggerty) Lillard, Dottie spent most of her life in both Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

In her adult life, Dottie was employed as a switchboard operator for Bell Telephone, but additionally, she held employment as a clerical worker with the New Jersey Department of Corrections from which she eventually retired. A long-time member of Pemberton Baptist Church in Pemberton, NJ, Dottie served the children of the church by working in Awana, VBS programs, and family events such as the annual Trunk or Treat. She was also actively involved in various women's ministries and programs at PBC. In her most recent years, Dottie was a faithful attendee of Red Lion Faith Chapel in Southampton, NJ where she was baptized and became a member. She enjoyed serving with the organization Addictions Answer by making sandwiches for the addicted and homeless in Kensington, Philadelphia.

Dottie was preceded in death by her first husband, William T. Hartman, Sr., in 2016; her second husband, Gordon Parks, in 2010; her third husband, George J. Smith, III, in 2023; and her oldest son, William T. Hartman, Jr., in 1994.
