Earle W. Johnson, Jr. of the Rancocas Village section of Westampton, died Sunday, December 28, 2008 at Lourdes Hospital in Willingboro. He was 87. Born in Camden, NJ, Mr. Johnson was a longtime resident of Rancocas. He was a US Navy Veteran of WW II and Plank Owner of the USS Antietam. He later was retired from the NJ Air National Guard and the US Air Force. He received the US Air Force Commendation Medal. Mr. Johnson was also a retired Aircraft Maintenance Supervisor. He was a member of the Rancocas Fire Company and the NJ Exempt Fireman's Association. Mr. Johnson was a Meals on Wheels Volunteer and a former Boy Scout Leader. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Mount Holly for over 40 years. He is survived by his wife Ruth R.; a daughter Lynne (Don) Schneider of Sterling, VA; 2 grandchildren Chris & Ruby; 5 nieces, 1 nephew, many great nieces, great nephews; and great, great nieces and great, great nephews. Funeral services will be held on Monday at 11:00 AM at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly, NJ. Interment will be private.
