Edward G. Clevenger, Sr. of Roebing, formerly of Ohio and Lumberton, passed away on Thursday, December 21, 2023, surrounded by his family, at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 74.

Born in Mount Holly, Ed was a longtime area resident. He was a US Army Veteran of Vietnam.
